But once in a while just turn around see.

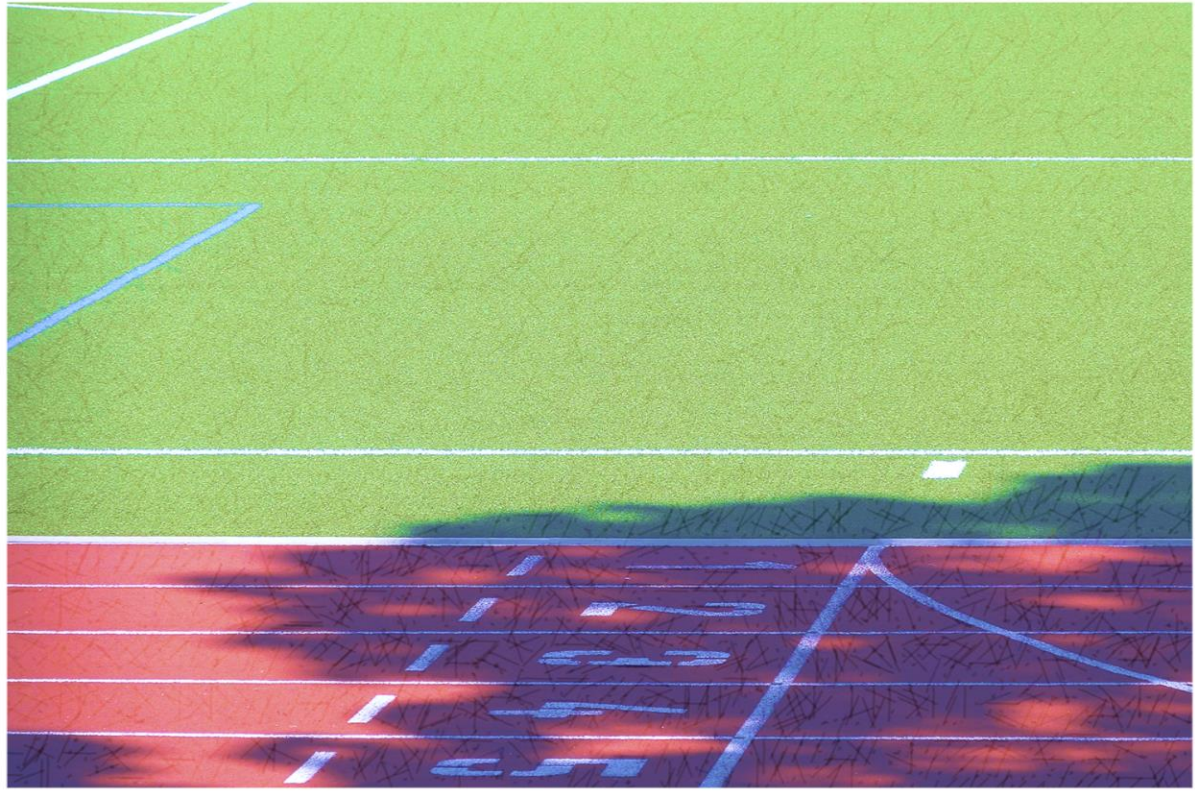
I'll always be waiting, no matter how far you run,
