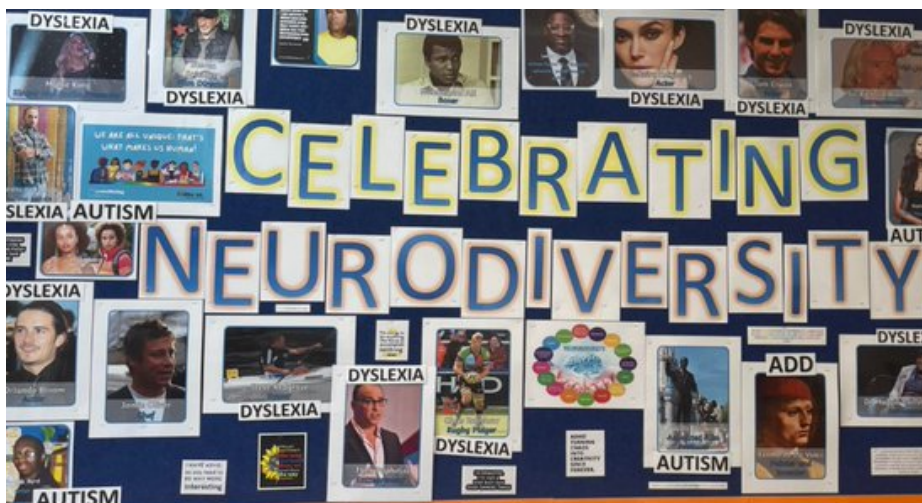


CYBER SECURITY

SATURDAY REVISION

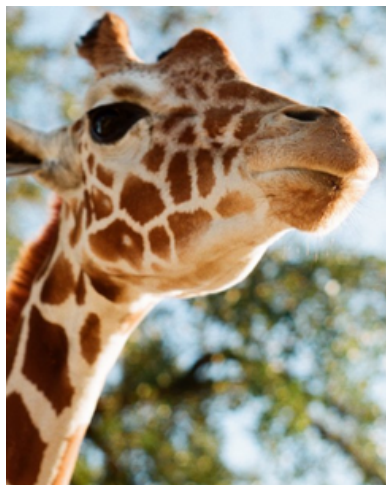
Another year, another Year 11 group – so impressive to see 93 students using Saturday morning revision in English, Maths & Science. Amazing staff and amazing students!
