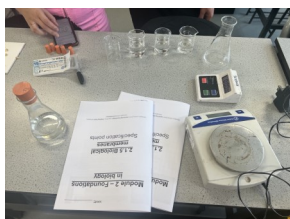
Sixth Form Learning Mentor
